Forage Variety Field / Plot Demonstration Package

We are pleased to be able to offer a number of fields of various sizes, with the largest being 30 acres. Forage field trials will be strictly on first come first served basis in negotiations with office holders and Farm Manager

If you would like to take advantage of this package it is a requirement that you purchase a Bronze Sponsor package. There is an opportunity for the companies to either upgrade to a Silver or Gold Package.

Equipment Demonstration in field £400.00/acre

We are able to offer demonstration plots of various sizes, with the largest field being 30 acres.

- The charge for a demonstration plot will be £400.00/acre.
- Mowing (see conditions) To facilitate spectator's viewing area a proportion of the field will be cut.
- Clamp demonstration time allocated in proportion to demonstration ground purchased.
- 2 complimentary Exhibitor passes per acre of demonstration ground purchased.
- 2 lunch tickets issued per acre of demonstration ground purchased.
- An opportunity to prioritise plot location if a sponsorship package is purchased

Equipment Demonstration in Clamp

The charge for a demonstration time is included in the plot price and time will be allocated pro-rata.

However if you do not wish to demonstrate in the field, arrangements and fee will be confirmed after deadline.

All silage demonstrators will need to use silage additive supplied FOC by Volac

Slurry and Muck demonstrations

Trade Stands

In addition to the General Terms and conditions, Trade Stand exhibitors agree to the following:

- Access for the preparation of the Trade Stands will be from 9.00 am to 7.00 pm on Wednesday 29th May 2024 and from 7:00am on the day.
- All stands must be on site by 8:00am on the day & vehicles must be removed off site by 8.00 am to the designated vehicle park.
- Trade stands must not be removed from the site until after 5:00pm on the day of the event.
- Staffing of trade stands must be continuous between 10.00 am and 5.00 pm on the day.
- No person other than an exhibitor who has applied for and been allocated space will be allowed to sell or display articles of any description on the site. Sub-letting of stands will not be permitted.
- No exhibitors shall be permitted to arrange their trade stand or to place their sign in such a manner as to obstruct the light or to inconvenience or disadvantageously affect the display of another exhibitor. No intrusion into neighbouring sites will be permitted.
- All indoor trade stands will be located within a marquee. Outdoor trade stands
 will be located on grass. Exhibitors with their own marquees must provide the
 organiser with a fire-resistant certificate and advise if they need to dig holes. All
 ground must be completely reinstated on removal of trade stands.
- Exhibitors must have a fire extinguisher on their trade stand.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for the removal of refuse from their trade stand
- Tables & Chairs not provided
- **Catering facilities will be available throughout the day on site*





Terms and Conditions

All exhibitors and trade stands will need to complete & submit a Risk-Assessment form online.

- The Royal Welsh Grassland Event will not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss to any exhibitor, articles or property brought onto the site.
- The Royal Welsh Grassland Event will not be responsible for any actions or expenses on account of or in respect of any such damage or injury caused.
- All exhibitors must have Full Third-Party Liability insurance. Certificate will need to be displayed during the event.
- All exhibitors indemnify the Royal Welsh Grassland Event from any claims made in connection with the exhibitor's staff, equipment, display or vehicles.
- Decisions of the Royal Welsh Grassland Event Organising Committee based on the interpretation of these conditions will be final.

Specific, additional terms are detailed below

Equipment exhibitors in Field and in Clamp

In addition to the General Terms and conditions, exhibitors demonstrating equipment in either the field or clamp agree to the following:

- Plot allocation will be finalised after the application date for "Equipment Demonstration" has passed.
- For publicity and printing, exhibitors should provide a demonstration itinerary.
- For the purpose of wilting, each demonstration plot must be mowed 1-2 days in advance. It is the responsibility of the companies demonstrating at the event to organise mowing of their demonstration area.
- To facilitate with mowing demonstrations, a separate area within the same field will be allocated to each exhibitor at a rate proportionate to size of plot purchased.
- Headlands of which form part of the plot will be cut prior to the event to facilitate spectators viewing area
- Plot exhibitors will provide their own public-address system.
- Access for the preparation of the Demonstration Plot will be: from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm on Tuesday 28th May 2024 and o from 9.00 am to 7.00 pm on Wednesday 29th 2024.
- All non-demonstration items and vehicles must be removed off site by 8.00 am on the day of the event to the designated vehicle park.
- Demonstration items must not be removed from the site until after 18:00 on the day of the event
