To be staged on a base 1.22m sq, 15cm deep.

NO backing will be provided in this class.

Height of exhibit can be unlimited.

TO BE STAGED BY NOT MORE THAN TWO PEOPLE – OPEN TO INDIVIDUALS, FLORAL SOCIETIES, CLUBS AND/OR ANY GROUPS.

An exhibit to be staged on a

white painted 75cm cube

(which will be provided) within a floor space of 1m sq. Height unlimited.

To be judged all round.

3. **‘Electricity’**

A contemporary exhibit

Space allowed 61cm width

and 68cm depth approximate.

Height of exhibit unlimited.

4. **‘A Jewel Garden’**

A floor exhibit.

Exhibitor to supply an appropriate

staging base. Space allowed 1 sq m.

Height of exhibit unlimited.

5. **‘A Rural Odyssey’**

A pave exhibit

Space allowed 76cm width, 68cm depth

and height unlimited.

6. **‘Southern Hemisphere’**

An exhibit.

Space allowed 76cm width,

68cm depth and height unlimited.

7. **‘Aqua’**

An exhibit.

Space allowed 76cm width,

68cm depth and height unlimited.

8. **IMPOSED CLASS**

This class is limited to the first 8 entries received once the full schedule has been circulated in 2024

It will be staged at 12 noon on Monday 22 July in the Floral Art area in full view of the public. The

title will be given at that stage. Space allowed 76cm width, 68cm depth and height unlimited.

9. **'A Bog Garden'**
A floor exhibit.
Exhibitor to supply an appropriate staging base. Space allowed 1 sq m.
Height of exhibit unlimited.
10. **'Flower Fairies'**
A petite exhibit featuring fresh plant material, use of accessories acceptable.
(Not to exceed 25cm in width and depth; height optional but has to be in proportion)
to be staged on plinths of varying heights, painted blue, which will be provided.
11. **'Shades of Green'**
A miniature exhibit featuring fresh plant material, use of accessories acceptable.
(Not to exceed 10cm in width and depth; height optional but has to be in proportion)
to be staged on a table covered in grey material.
12. **'In the Pink'**
An exhibit. ***This class open only to competitors who are either under 30 years of age or a complete novice.***
Space allowed 76cm width, 68cm depth and height unlimited.

Dosbarthiadau WI & Merched y Wawr Classes:

13. **'Myth neu Chwedl Gymreig / A Welsh Myth or Legend'**
An exhibit open only to the winner of WI qualifying competitions. Federation and exhibitor's name to be stated.
Space allowed 76cm width, 68cm depth and height unlimited.
14. **'Crefftau Gwledig/Cefn Gwlad'**
Arddangosfa ar agor yn unig ar gyfer enillwyr cystadlaethau rhagbrofol Merched y Wawr.
Enw'r Mudiad a'r gystadleuydd i'w datgan.
Man arddangos lled 76cm, 68cm dyfnder a uchder yn anghyfyngedig.

15. One stem of Cluster Flowered (Floribunda) Rose, any cultivar(s)
(exhibitors may make up to 3 entries in this class)
16. Bowl of Cluster Flowered
Roses **not more than** nine stems, any cultivar(s)

17. Vase of five stems of Cluster Flowered (Floribunda) Roses, any cultivar(s)
18. Bowl of Large Flowered (H.T.) Roses **not more than** nine stems, any cultivar(s)
19. Vase of five stems of Large Flowered (H.T.) Roses, any cultivar(s)
20. HT Rose exhibited in a picture frame. Additional same cultivar foliage may be added.
21. Vase of **not more than** 5 stems of Miniature Roses (Cluster Flowered type), any cultivar(s)
22. Bowl of **not more than** 9 stems of miniature Roses, (H.T. type), one bloom per stem, any cultivar(s)
23. Box of six blooms of miniature Roses (H.T.type) any cultivar(s)
24. Bowl of **not more than** 9 stems of Miniflora Roses, one bloom per stem, any cultivar(s)
25. Miniflora Rose (HT type) exhibited in a picture frame. Additional same cultivar foliage may be added.

26. One pot of a single or semi-double cultivar, pot not exceeding 15cm.
27. One mini standard, pot not exceeding 13cm.

29. A hanging pot of a single, semi-double or double cultivar, pot not exceeding 25cm.
30. One pot of Triphylla Type, pot not exceeding 20cm.

Medium, small or miniature.
Cactus or semi.
Any cultivar(s)
32. THREE DAHLIAS – of the same size
Medium, small or miniature decs or ball

Vase of five 55mm or Vase of three 83mm.
Any cultivar(s)
34. THREE DAHLIAS – of the same kind
WATERLILIES OR FIMBRIATED
Any cultivar(s)
35. DAHLIAS
COLLARETTE AND/OR STAR
Nine in a basket.
Basket will be provided.
36. **THREE VASE CLASS -**
Any 3 vases out of Class 31 – 35 (Collarette and/or Star can be included but must be 3 in a vase)

ADLAN CARNASIYNAU / CARNATION SECTION

37. 5 blooms of any cultivar
or cultivars.
38. 3 blooms of self, any cultivar
or cultivars.

ADLAN BLODAU'R CLEDDYF / GLADIOLI SECTION

38. Vase of one single spike, any cultivar.
(exhibitors may make up to 3 entries in this class)

ADLAN LILI / LILY SECTION

39. Vase of three stems,
any cultivar.

DOSBARTH FFIOL ORAU Y SIOE FRENHINOL/ THE ROYAL WELSH TOP VASE CLASS

40. A vase of mixed flowering stems
containing a total of between
5 and 10 stems, taken from a minimum
of two different kinds of plants.

ADRAN PLANHIGYN POT / POT PLANT SECTION

- 41. POT PLANT Flowering,
(excl. Fuchsia, Pelargonium and Streptocarpus).
Any size pot.
- 42. POT PLANT Foliage,
(excl. Fuchsia and Pelargonium).
Any size pot.
- 43. ONE CACTUS
Any size pot.
- 44. ONE SUCCULENT
Any size pot.
- 45. ONE STREPTOCARPUS
Any size pot.

ADRAN MYNAWYD Y BUGAIL / PELARGONIUM SECTION

- 46. One plant zonal.
Pot not to exceed 15cm in diameter.
- 47. One pot of any cultivars
Any size pot.

PENCAMPWRIAETH PYS PERSAWR CENEDLAETHOL CYMRU/ NATIONAL SWEET PEA CHAMPIONSHIP OF WALES

- 48. SIX VASES DISTINCT
no more than 12 stems to be shown in each vase.
- 49. THREE VASES DISTINCT
Restricted to growers who grow **not**
more than 250 plants. **No more than** 9 stems to be shown in each vase.
- 50. ONE MIXED VASE
Not more than 15 stems.
- 51. MIXED BOWL
A bowl of not more than 24 stems of
Sweet Peas with any foliage. To be
viewed from the front and judged for
quality and decorative effect. Bowls provided.
- 52. OPEN SINGLE VASE
One Vase, of up to 9 stems, of any ONE cultivar from any Spencer classification.
(Exhibitors may make more than one entry, up to 3 entries if of a different cultivar, in this class)

53. SINGLE STEM - Best single stem in vase of Spencer cultivar, any colour.
54. NOVICE CLASS - ONE VASE OF MIXED SPENCER CULTIVARS – 12 STEMS
Open only to those who grow less than 100 Sweet Pea Plants and have never won a First Prize with Sweet Peas at this Show..
55. **SWEET PEA CORONATION OPEN CLASS**
To include a Bowl of mixed Spencer Sweet Peas (any amount, foliage and gypsophila allowed) AND a Vase of mixed Spencer Sweet Peas, front facing (any amount in a 7.5cm diameter vase). Bowl and Vase provided
56. MIXED BOWL OF OLD FASHIONED SWEET PEAS
A bowl of not more than 24 stems of Sweet Peas with any foliage. To be viewed from all around and judged for quality and decorative effect. Bowls provided.

57. **“TRUG OF VEGETABLES”**
Best presented trug of vegetables and/or salad vegetables. Trug not to exceed 60cm x 30cm in size
58. 9 Pods Peas.
59. 5 Potatoes, White or Coloured, any variety (on a plate).
60. 5 Tomatoes with Calyx attached (on a plate).
61. 3 Carrots, other than long
62. 6 French Beans.
63. 6 Broad Beans.
64. 3 Onions, under 250g each. Any colour or variety
65. 9 Shallots, large (on a plate).
66. 9 Shallots, pickling (on a plate).
67. 2 Cucumbers.
68. Any Other Vegetable not listed (eg. 6 Runner Beans; 2 Celery; 2 Cauliflower; Any Other - 3 specimens)
69. Herbs – 6 varieties to be named. Arranged for effect.

70. One plate of any types of Soft Fruit
71. A plate of up to 20
Gooseberries of any variety.
72. A plate of blackcurrants or redcurrants any variety.

73. **“A MIXED HANGING BASKET”**
not exceeding 35.5cm diameter hanging basket

not exceeding 40.5cm diameter. The container
to be suitably planted for outside display
75. **“WINDOW BOX DISPLAY”**
Box not provided. Maximum measurements
90cm long, 23cm wide, 23cm deep.
