All entries will be processed on a **first come, first serve basis** as and when they arrive at the Livestock Office. Hand delivered entries received on the first day, will be classed as arriving on the second day and picked out at random. The schedule will be available on-line to view from Wednesday 27th March 2024, with entry forms available from Wednesday 10th April 2024 at 10am. Any entries received with **no payment**, will only be processed once payment has been received. If a payment cheque for entries is returned from the bank, the Society will charge a fee of £25.

TOCYNNAU A PHASIAU · TICKETS AND PASSES

Immediately, upon receipt of tickets and passes, exhibitors are requested to check that the allocation is correct. No duplicate tickets or passes will be issued during the Show period free of charge.

i) Exhibitor refunds and declaration of non-attendance Refunds in exceptional circumstances.

The Society will only issue a refund after 19 June 2024 in extreme exceptional circumstances, such as government restrictions, serious illness or death. Any such refund would be subject to all tickets and passes being returned to the Livestock Office no later than 14 July 2024, with a receipt as proof of return. Those who post their tickets must do so by recorded delivery, with the proof of postage retained.

Any exhibitor who is unable to attend the event **must** inform the Society in writing by 19 June 2024, a partial refund will then be issued. After this date, although no refund will be issued, exhibitors must still inform the Livestock Office of their absence in writing. Any tickets and passes received must be returned, unused, directly to the Livestock Office by 14 July 2024, with a receipt as proof of return.

Failure by any exhibitor to notify the Society of their absence in writing and return any tickets or passes received may result in action being taken against that exhibitor. Under the terms of the Society's Disciplinary Procedure, any exhibitor who is found to have breached the Society's rules may be barred from exhibiting at future shows for a period of time.

ii) If unable to compete during the event, due to animal injury.

Any exhibitor whose animal becomes injured whilst on the Showground and is unable to compete in its class, must be certified by one of the Society's vets. The Vets certificate MUST then be supplied to the Livestock Office. Failure to adhere to these procedures may result in disciplinary action being taken as per above.

NO PLOTS WILL BE HELD FOR A SPECIFIC SECTION.

Exhibitors please be aware that due to demand, not all requests may be accommodated, but alternatives will be offered in this instance. Also, it will not be possible for all caravan plots to have an electrical hook-up, but exhibitors will be informed of this and refunded £60 prior to the Show. Please stipulate if you do not wish to have an electrical hook-up, and you will be accommodated in the North 12 caravan park at £110 per plot. Please note that a camper van is considered the same as a caravan by the Society and, therefore, a caravan pass should be ordered if you intend to bring a camper van to the Show.

There will be additional caravan spaces at Wernfawr, which can accommodate livestock exhibitors and vehicle passes will allow access on site to attend to livestock, but entry will be prohibited after 8am.

With Health and Safety/Fire Regulations having to be rigorously administered, exhibitors **MUST** state on their entry form if their vehicle will be used for accommodation during the Show. There will not be a fee for exhibitors using their vehicles for accommodation. Exhibitors are restricted to **ONE CARAVAN** plot **ONLY PER ADDRESS.** Exhibitors entering carcasses only are not permitted to book a caravan plot. Exhibitors requiring caravan plots are requested to submit their entries in good time as these are very limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

To ensure compliance with Fire Safety Regulations, all caravans will be required to be spaced six metres between caravan walls and three metres clear between associated equipment (e.g., Car or awning) and the adjacent caravan. All caravans and other vehicles used for accommodation **MUST** carry a suitable fire extinguisher (5-kilo dry powder type).

Equine Exhibitors only – A caravan will not be admitted onto the site via Horse Hill if it is being towed by a lorry.

Children are always the responsibility of parents and carers whilst on the Showground including the caravan and camping parks. Unaccompanied children under the age of 12 are not admitted to the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society show's and must not be left unaccompanied in a caravan or tent.

While accompanied children are welcome in most caravanning and camping areas at the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society shows the livestock caravan park and camping area (Exhibitors) is not suitable for children under 16.

CYRRAEDD · ARRIVAL

All vehicles will be inspected upon arrival.

MEWNFORIO AC ALLFORIO GWARTHEG · IMPORT AND EXPORT OF CATTLE

Any exhibitor bringing imported cattle to the Show, or who shall be exporting any cattle exhibited at the Show, after the event, are required to contact the Animal Health Office prior to the Show (Tel: 029 207 68500) The cattle prize money scale, which is based on the number of cattle forward in each class for judging, is as follows: -

The herdsperson of the Breed Champion will receive £10. Prize winners are required to parade on the third and fourth days of the Show.

TALU GWOBRAU ARIANNOL · PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be the responsibility of the owed competitor to claim. The process of claiming prize money will be via your RWAS account. You will receive an explanatory email of how to claim your prize money when available to claim, unless an exhibitor has specifically requested otherwise. When processed and approved, in accordance with the terms of the Society's Rules & Regulations, payments for prizes awarded at the RWAS, where there is no dispute, will be made not later than one month after the Event. Any outstanding amounts due to the Society may be set-off against any prize money or other amount owed to the exhibitor.

TALIADAU YMGEISIO · ENTRY FEES

Each entry is £13.00 for members of the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society and £26.00 for non-members. There are no entry fees for group or progeny specials and no prize money is payable except where special prizes are offered.

Failure by any exhibitor to notify the Society of their absence in writing and return any tickets or passes received, may result in action being taken against that exhibitor. Under the terms of the Society's Disciplinary Procedure, any exhibitor who is found to have breached the Society's rules may be barred from exhibiting at future shows for a period of time.

The closing date of entries is 22nd May 2024.

TALIADAU CÔR · STALL FEES

A fee of £60.00 (including VAT) will be charged for each stall. A stall must be booked for EACH exhibit that will be forward at the Show. All cattle entered in the show classes MUST be housed in the cattle buildings and **NOT** on a tradestand. A full refund will be issued if a stall is cancelled in writing and received before 12 June 2024, we kindly ask that after this date we are notified if stalls will not be used. A refund of £50 (Including VAT) will be issued if the exhibit is forward for Judging at the Show.

Beef Cattle

It is up to the exhibitor whether they feel that they require a calf stall. Calf stalls are charged at £60 per stall. Beef cattle exhibitors are restricted to a **maximum of TEN stalls (including calf stalls).** Beef cattle exhibitors will not be allowed to book tack stalls. As far as possible – The alleyway between the stalls must be kept clear of tack and equipment, Stewards will identify suitable tack storage locations upon arrival.

Dairy Cattle

Tack stalls will be allocated upon arrival, we ask that exhibitors avoid bringing non-cattle related equipment to the aisles and that exhibitors store hay behind cattle's back legs were possible.

Kindly note that the Society will not allow exhibitors to use stalls which they have booked if they are not being used to stall cattle. No refund will be given to exhibitors if an unused stall is re-drafted back to the Society to re-allocate during the Show. Exhibitors are advised to cancel any unwanted stalls by 19 June 2024. Any exhibitor failing to comply with this regulation will be noted and action may be taken by the Society's Board of Directors following the Show.

Beef Cattle

Tack stalls will be allocated upon arrival, we ask that exhibitors avoid bringing non-cattle related equipment to the aisles and that exhibitors store hay behind cattle's back legs were possible.

Kindly note that the Society will not allow exhibitors to use stalls which they have booked if they are not being used to stall cattle. No refund will be given to exhibitors if an unused stall is re-drafted back to the Society to re-allocate during the Show. Exhibitors are advised to cancel any unwanted stalls by 19 June 2024. Any exhibitor failing to comply with this regulation will be noted and action may be taken by the Society's Board of Directors following the Show.

GWELLT · STRAW

Cattle exhibitors will receive sufficient straw tickets upon arrival, during the scanning of their passports. Two tickets per exhibit present (one ticket = 1 bale). Initial straw will be provided. No straw will be delivered on Thursday 25 July. Delivery times will be announced over the sound system.

CYRRAEDD - ARRIVAL

ALL cattle must be on the Showground no later than 3.00pm, Sunday 21 July.

THESE TIMES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.

The arrival times allowed are as follows: -

Any exhibitor who arrives after the stipulated arrival times shall be recorded and referred to the Society's Livestock Committee following the Show. If in extreme circumstances an exhibitor is unable to arrive within these times, then the Society should be informed (Tel: 01982 5544 13/14/04)

YMADAWIAD - DEPARTURE

Will be permitted after the conclusion of the Grand Parade or between 3.30pm - 4.30pm on Thursday, 25 July – or whichever is sooner.

CYMHWYSTER · ELIGIBILITY

All exhibits (except for Commercial Cattle) must be registered in their respective Society's Herd Book.

GWASANAETH MIL-FEDDYGOL · VETERINARY SERVICE

Will be available on the Showground from 8.00am, Saturday 20 July. After 7.00pm, contact should be made via the veterinary compound as marked on show plan. All inspections will be made free of charge. However, any treatment will be charged for.

CARDIAU PERFFORMIAD - PERFORMANCE CARDS

The Society is anxious to improve the educational aspect of the Show by displaying Breedplan/Taurus cards in the beef cattle section for the young bulls and heifers that are performance recorded.

PASPORTAU GWARTHEG · CATTLE PASSPORTS

Passports (CPP 1 or CPP 13 2/98) are required for all bovines born on or after 1 July 1996. The passport must accompany the animals and remain on the Showground for the duration of the animals' attendance. The movement to and from the Show should be entered on the passport. The passport should be completed in the usual way for any other movements of the animals. A continuation passport should be applied for in good time before or during the Show season.

BRUCELLOSIS - GWARTHEG YN LLOIA - ERTHYLU AR FAES Y SIOE BRUCELLOSIS - CATTLE CALVING - ABORTING ON THE SHOWGROUND

An animal calving at full term should be placed immediately in the approved isolation accommodation or returned immediately to its premises of origin after receiving permission from the Society.

If the owner wishes to return it to the cattle lines they may, at the discretion of the Show Director or his nominee, arrange for a blood sample and vaginal swab to be taken privately and examined at an approved laboratory. If both the Rose Bengal Plate Test (RBPT) and microscopical examination of a smear made from the swab are negative, the animal may then leave isolation. Welsh Government will not be responsible for any fee or other charges incurred in this respect. Animals calving prematurely or aborting must immediately be placed in the approved isolation accommodation and the AHVLA at the Showground will be informed by the Show Director. If an animal calves or aborts before it can be isolated, full precautions must be taken to isolate and disinfect any possibly contaminated standings, bedding, utensils and vehicles.

The AHVLA will serve a BS 27 Isolation Notice on the owner or person in charge and arrange an investigation (either by an OV) ensuring that the full range of samples is obtained. The animal under investigation will remain in isolation whilst on the Showground. Once fit to travel, it can return home or remain in isolation until the end of the Show. If the animal is moved before the BS 27 Notice is lifted, a Movement Licence will be required, obtained from the AHVLA. The AHVLA for the Show will notify the AHVLA of the Division of the registered premises of the circumstances of the abortion so that a further BS 27 can be served isolating the animal pending the results of further laboratory investigations.

All other bovine animals from the same registered premises will not be allowed to compete further in the Show until negative results for an RBPT and microscopical examination of the smear from the aborting animal have been received. The degree of direct and indirect contact between the animal(s) under investigation and all other cattle on the Showground will be assessed and appropriate measures taken.

DIOGELWCH TYRFA YN ADEILADAU'R GWARTHEG CROWD SAFETY IN CATTLE BUILDINGS

No cattle affected with warbles will be accepted even after treatment.

In the interests of public safety, the cattle buildings will be closed whilst the main movements of cattle for judging, and the parades are in progress.

Cattle exhibitors' badges will admit them to the building at all times. This badge is not transferable and no one other than badge holders will be allowed to enter. This procedure is for the benefit of all concerned and your co-operation in making it work would be much appreciated.

Please note that all cattle stalled at the Royal Welsh Show should be double tied.

TYWYSWYR - HANDLERS

All handlers must be a minimum of 14 years old on the first day of the Show for the judging of ALL cattle classes and for the Main Ring parade. <u>Cattle/Dairy</u> Sections a maximum of **Two** handlers per animal is permitted whilst competing or parading in the rings at the Show. <u>Commercial Cattle</u>, only **One** Handler per animal is permitted whilst competing or parading in the rings at the Show.

BOVINE TB

All bovine animals attending the show (over the age of 42 days) will require a valid current TB test (tested within 60 day of the show dates) irrespective of the status of their holding.

For ALL TB Movement Enquiries, please contact your local APHA Office.

DOLUR RHYDD FEIRYSOL BUCHOL • BVD REQUIREMENTS

Cattle must reside in a herd enrolled in a recognised BVD eradication programme or have been tested individually for evidence of the BVD virus with a negative result.

Therefore, in order to show your animals, we require proof of BVD testing and negative status when cattle arrive. This can be at a herd level or individual animal level. This requirement will ensure that all cattle shown at this year's show will be BVD tested, ensuring no PI animals are present.

The following documentation will be accepted as proof of BVD status:

- Recognised Accredited Herd Status Certificate
- Individual animal result Negative (antigen)
- Blood tested as a Calf with a negative result

You will need an individual BVD antigen result for the animals you are showing (test can be done through blood samples or tissue tagging).

Important – Herd status (antibody results) must be current – no older than <u>12</u> months before the date of arrival at the show.

- Vaccination against BVD is recommended but not compulsory
- Checks will be carried out to ensure Herd Health Status.

AELODAETH - MEMBERSHIP

To qualify to enter at members' rates, exhibitors must be **fully paid up** members of the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society Ltd **UPON ENTRY**. Please check that your RWAS account shows your membership status before adding any entries/items to your basket. If items/entries are added to your basket with incorrect membership status you **WILL** be charged the non-member rate. **Refunds will not be given**.

· CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

Cancellation of Classes

As per our Rules & Regulations Rule 12

- a) The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel or transfer any section or class if they deem there to be insufficient entries. In the event of any class or section being cancelled entrants therein will be notified as soon as possible by email, after the closing date of entries and their fees will be returned.
- **b)** If, at the discretion of the RWAS Society, two or more Dairy breeds are amalgamated owing to insufficient entries, a Champion in each individual breed will be chosen.
- c) The RWAS Society reserves the right, at their discretion, to amalgamate classes, as appropriate, which they deem to have insufficient entries.

TICKET ENTITLEMENT

Exhibitor ticket entitlement for the HORSE section: -

Horse exhibitors will receive one more ticket than horses entered on any day, up to a maximum of five tickets per day. For example, an exhibitor with two horses, one showing on Monday and one showing on Tuesday, will receive four one day tickets: two tickets for the horse shown on the Monday and two tickets for the horse shown on the Tuesday.

Additional adult one-day tickets may be purchased at £32.00 (including VAT) each and additional child one-day tickets may be purchased at £5.00 (including VAT).
