All entries will be processed on a **first come**, **first serve basis** as and when they arrive at the Livestock Office. Hand delivered entries received on the first day, will be classed as arriving on the second day and picked out at random. The schedule will be available on-line to view from Friday 27th March 2024, with entry forms available from Wednesday 10th April 2024 at 10am. Any entries received with **no payment**, will only be processed once payment has been received. If a payment cheque for entries is returned from the bank, the Society will charge a fee of £25.

Immediately, upon receipt of tickets and passes, exhibitors are requested to check that the allocation is correct. No duplicate tickets or passes will be issued during the Show period free of charge.

i) Exhibitor refunds and declaration of non-attendance Refunds in exceptional circumstances.

The Society will only issue a refund after 19 June 2024 in extreme exceptional circumstances, such as government restrictions, serious illness or death. Any such refund would be subject to all tickets and passes being returned to the Livestock Office no later than 14 July 2024, with a receipt as proof of return. Those who post their tickets must do so by recorded delivery, with the proof of postage retained.

Any exhibitor who is unable to attend the event **must** inform the Society in writing by 19 June 2024, a partial refund will then be issued. After this date, although no refund will be issued, exhibitors must still inform the Livestock Office of their absence in writing. Any tickets and passes received must be returned, unused, directly to the Livestock Office by 14 July 2024, with a receipt as proof of return.

Failure by any exhibitor to notify the Society of their absence in writing and return any tickets or passes received may result in action being taken against that exhibitor. Under the terms of the Society's Disciplinary Procedure, any exhibitor who is found to have breached the Society's rules may be barred from exhibiting at future shows for a period of time.

ii) If unable to compete during the event, due to animal injury.

Any exhibitor whose animal becomes injured whilst on the Showground and is unable to compete in its class, must be certified by one of the Society's vets. The Vets certificate MUST then be supplied to the Livestock Office. Failure to adhere to these procedures may result in disciplinary action being taken as per above.

AELODAETH · MEMBERSHIP

To qualify to enter at members' rates, exhibitors must be **fully paid-up** members of the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society Ltd **UPON ENTRY**. Please check that you RWAS account shows your membership status before adding any entries/items to your basket. THIS INCLUDES DAIRY CATTLE CARAVANS

ALL CARAVANS WILL BE ALLOCATED ON A **FIRST COME FIRST SERVED** BASIS. **NO PLOTS WILL BE HELD** FOR A SPECIFIC SECTION.

Exhibitors please be aware that due to demand, not all requests may be accommodated, but alternatives will be offered in this instance. Also, it will not be possible for all caravan plots to have an electrical hook-up, but exhibitors will be informed of this and refunded £60 prior to the Show. Please stipulate if you do not wish to have an electrical hook-up, and you may be accommodated in the North 12 caravan park at £110 per plot. Please note that a camper van is considered the same as a caravan by the Society and, therefore, a caravan pass should be ordered if you intend to bring a camper van to the Show.

There will be additional caravan spaces at Wernfawr, which can accommodate livestock exhibitors and vehicle passes will allow access on site to attend to livestock, but entry will be prohibited after 8am.

With Health and Safety/Fire Regulations having to be rigorously administered, exhibitors **MUST** state on their entry form if their vehicle will be used for accommodation during the Show. There will not be a fee for exhibitors using their vehicles for accommodation. Exhibitors are restricted to **ONE CARAVAN** plot **ONLY PER ADDRESS.** Exhibitors entering carcasses only are not permitted to book a caravan plot. Exhibitors requiring caravan plots are requested to submit their entries in good time as these are very limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

To ensure compliance with Fire Safety Regulations, all caravans will be required to be spaced six metres between caravan walls and three metres clear between associated equipment (e.g., Car or awning) and the adjacent caravan. All caravans and other vehicles used for accommodation **MUST** carry a suitable fire extinguisher (5-kilo dry powder type).

Equine Exhibitors only – A caravan will not be admitted onto the site via Horse Hill if it is being towed by a lorry.

Children are always the responsibility of parents and carers whilst on the Showground including the caravan and camping parks. Unaccompanied children under the age of 12 are not admitted to the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society show's and must not be left unaccompanied in a caravan or tent.

While accompanied children are welcome in most caravanning and camping areas at the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society shows the livestock caravan park and camping area (Exhibitors) is not suitable for children under 16.

CYRRAEDD · ARRIVAL

All vehicles will be inspected upon arrival.

The Livestock Gate, Entrance C (Livestock entries only, not including horses) will be open for the arrival and inspection of vehicles and their stock at the following times: -

Entries & Vehicles may be refused entry on to the site if outside of these stated times.

All breed Champions must be paraded, if not the prize money will be withheld. All breed Champions MUST be forward for the Champion of Champions, if not their prize money will be withheld.

TALU GWOBRAU ARIANNOL - PAYMENT OF PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be the responsibility of the owed competitor to claim. The process of claiming prize money will be via your RWAS account. You will receive an explanatory email of how to claim your prize money when available to claim, unless an exhibitor has specifically requested otherwise. When processed and approved, in accordance with the terms of the Society's Rules & Regulations, payments for prizes awarded at the RWAS, where there is no dispute, will be made not later than one month after the Event. Any outstanding amounts due to the Society may be set-off against any prize money or other amount owed to the exhibitor.

Sheep exhibitors are limited to <u>TWO</u> entries per class, unless otherwise specified.

Each entry in the sheep classes will be £37.50 for members of the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society and £45.00 for non-members. The entry fee includes a £30 deposit which will be refunded if the animal is presented in the ring at the Show. If entries are withdrawn, in writing, prior to Wednesday, 19 June, a full refund shall be issued.

Failure by any exhibitor to notify the Society of their absence in writing and return any tickets or passes received, may result in action being taken against that exhibitor. Under the terms of the Society's Disciplinary Procedure, any exhibitor who is found to have breached the Society's rules may be barred from exhibiting at future shows for a period of time.

Group classes require an entry fee but there are no entry fees for specials marked with a **S.** and no prize money is payable except where special prizes are offered.

The CLOSING date of entries is 22 May 2024 – 11.59pm, NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN/ACCEPTED

An exhibitor who has made an entry of horses, cattle, sheep, pigs or goats in a particular class, will be permitted, up to the 1 June 2024, to withdraw the entry of such animal and to substitute for it an entry of another animal in the same class which was his or her bona fide property at the time of his or her original entry.

SUBSTITUTIONS INTO THE SAME CLASS

No substitutions will be accepted after 1 June 2024 (except as provided for under Rules & Regulations 26 below). This must be provided in writing, email, or letter.

REFUNDS ON WITHDRAWALS

Whilst we appreciate that unforeseen circumstances can result in last minute withdrawals, this can create additional administration duties for the society. Therefore a 5% administration charge will be taken for all withdrawals when claimed from your RWAS Account. The credit can be used to purchase additional products/entries without incurring an administration fee.

DUE TO INCREASING INTEREST WITHIN THE SHEEP SECTION, CAPICITY IS AT ITS MAXIMUM.

IF THE NEED ARISES, WE, THE ROYAL WELSH AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REDUCE ENTRIES AND PENS. THIS WILL BE DONE VIA THE DATE STAMPED ENTRIES – REDUCING FROM THE LAST ENTRY RECEIVED AND WORKING BACKWARDS. EXHIBITORS WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA EMAIL AND ENTRIES CANCELLED. A FULL REFUND WILL BE ISSUED.

TALIADAU LLOC -PEN FEES

A fee of £10.00 (including VAT) will be charged for each pen in the sheep section. The fee may be refunded if the pen is cancelled in writing and received before 19 June 2024.

DOSBARTHU CORLANNAU - PEN ALLOCATION

The pen allocation will be as follows

Entries	Pens
1 - 2 entry	1 Pen
2 - 3 entries	2 Pens
4 or more entries	3 pens

This pen allocation is to ensure that all exhibitors and breeds are given a chance to show at the event. Exhibitors should ensure that they are not contravening animal welfare regulations when penning their sheep and consideration should be given on this matter when entering.

**It is recommended that sheep are housed with a maximum of two sheep per pen, due to the possibility of heat stress in very hot weather.

Upon arrival at the Show, exhibitors will only have those pens previously booked and paid for allocated to them. Pens will be allocated prior to the Show. Each pen is approximately 1.5m x 1.5m.

Exhibitors will not be allowed to book any extra pens. If space is available, the Society will provide an area for exhibitors to store their tack.

All sheep entered in the sheep classification must be housed in the sheep lines and not on a tradestand.

NO PALLETS ARE TO BE PLACED IN PENS TO ELEVATE SHEEP.

No Exhibitor will be allowed access to the showground or sheds to set up their pens prior to Saturday 8am.

Any Exhibitor found to be interfering with or setting up pens prior to the show opening at Saturday 8am may face a disciplinary process.

GWELLT · STRAW

Sheep exhibitors will receive sufficient straw tickets upon arrival, when handing in their movement documents, one ticket per three exhibits (one ticket = 1 bale). Initial straw will be provided. No straw will be delivered on Thursday 25 July. Delivery times will be announced.

FFANIAU CLUDADWY - PORTABLE FANS

Please be aware that the Society will **no longer permit** the use of portable electric fans within the sheep building. This rule has been introduced due to Health & Safety, Fire and Welfare reasons. The Society has put in place some protocols in the event of extreme temperatures and the Society's vets will be monitoring the buildings and will take appropriate action if required.

To promote airflow, we kindly ask ALL **exhibitors** for their cooperation by only placing their banners and sheets **on the BACK of their pens**, leaving the sides unrestricted so that the air is able to move freely through the shed.

No Electrical or Battery Powered Equipment are to be used in any of the Sheep Lines (*Except Battery Fans*).

PARATOI - PREPARATION

To comply with Health and Safety Regulations the use of any substance containing toxic chemicals, including sheep dips, to prepare sheep for showing whilst on the Showground is strictly forbidden. Any defaulter will be asked to leave the Showground and the matter may be put before the Society's Disciplinary Panel for their consideration, with the possibility of the exhibitor being barred for a period deemed appropriate. **The Society reserves the right to take samples to test any substance used on the sheep.**

ARWYDDION BRÎD / BREED BOARDS

To improve the airflow and visual aspect in the Sheep Sheds, exhibitors are now permitted to have one breed board per breed of sheep they have entered with a maximum board size of 4ft x 2.6ft. Exhibitors are also reminded that breed boards should not contain any content that is not deemed appropriate for a family show. If, in the opinion of the Society's stewards, a board is not deemed acceptable, it will be removed.

CYRRAEDD · ARRIVAL

THESE TIMES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.

ALL sheep must be on the Showground no later than 3.00 pm, Sunday, 21 July.

The arrival times allowed are as follows: -

Saturday 20th July	8.00am - 9.00pm
Sunday 21st July	8.00am - 3.00pm

Any exhibitor who arrives after the stipulated arrival times shall be recorded and referred to the Society's Livestock Committee following the Show. YMADAWIAD · DEPARTURE

Will be permitted after the conclusion of the Grand Parade or between 3.30pm - 4.30pm on Thursday, 25 July – or whichever is sooner.

All exhibits (except for Commercial Cattle) must be registered in their respective Society's Herd Book.

CYMHWYSTER · ELIGIBILITY

Every exhibitor MUST be a member in their own right of their respective Breed Society by 10 April 2024 and all sheep must be shown to Breed Society rules. All ewes, other than shearlings, must have reared lambs in 2024. All lambs must have been born in 2024 unless otherwise stated.

Exhibitors' must ensure that they comply with the requirements of national legislation for Recording, Identification and Movement of sheep in force at the time of the Show. Please note that the Showground is not a Central Point Recording Centre (CPRC). Exhibitors are therefore required to record the individual tag numbers down on their AML1 document. The movements licence must be FULLY completed prior to arrival.

GWASANAETH MIL-FEDDYGOL · VETERINARY SERVICE

Will be available on the Showground from 8.00am, Saturday 20 July. After 7.00 pm, contact should be made via the veterinary compound as marked on show plan or via the Veterinary Team's mobile phone number, which will be provided during the event. All inspections will be made free of charge. However, any treatment will be charged for.

TYWYSWYR - HANDLERS

All persons present in the Sheep Ring during judging, handling sheep in the Main Ring Parade or present with sheep handlers in the Main Ring Parade, **MUST be a minimum of 11 years old on the first day** of the Show. (This rule does not apply to the Young Handler Competition).

Only **ONE** handler per sheep is permitted in the ring during judging and in the parades.

AELODAETH · MEMBERSHIP

To qualify to enter at members' rates, exhibitors must be **fully paid up** members of the Royal Welsh Agricultural Society Ltd **UPON ENTRY**. · CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

Cancellation of Classes

As per our Rules & Regulations Rule 12

- a) The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel or transfer any section or class if they deem there to be insufficient entries. In the event of any class or section being cancelled entrants therein will be notified as soon as possible by email, after the closing date of entries and their fees will be returned.
- **b)** If, at the discretion of the RWAS Society, two or more Dairy breeds are amalgamated owing to insufficient entries, a Champion in each individual breed will be chosen.
- c) The RWAS Society reserves the right, at their discretion, to amalgamate classes, as appropriate, which they deem to have insufficient entries.

· TICKET ENTITLEMENT

Exhibitor ticket entitlement for the HORSE section: -

Horse exhibitors will receive one more ticket than horses entered on any day, up to a maximum of five tickets per day. For example, an exhibitor with two horses, one showing on Monday and one showing on Tuesday, will receive four one day tickets: two tickets for the horse shown on the Monday and two tickets for the horse shown on the Tuesday.

Additional adult one-day tickets may be purchased at £32.00 (including VAT) each and additional child one-day tickets may be purchased at £5.00 (including VAT).
