All Teams must report to the judge **AT LEAST** 15 minutes before the time stated and be ready to enter for any stage of the competition with a rest period of 6 minutes between each round of the competition and between separate competitions.

It is contrary to W.T.O.W.A Laws to accept an entry that is not submitted on this.

Teams who do not turn up for their chosen entered event will be liable for the full cost of entry tickets as supplied by the RWAS.
