#### **On-line Entries**

For 2020 you will now be able to enter on-line. If you need any assistance with this please follow the film on the website or get in touch.

#### **Traditional Gypsy Cobs (Saturday 16 May)**

In-Hand and Ridden classes have been introduced this year for both Traditional and Part Bred Traditional Gypsy Cobs.

#### **Novice Section (Saturday 16 May)**

The Novice section has been split this year into Ponies and Horses. In the Ponies section two new classes have been added – Mixed Height Show Hunter Pony and Mixed Height Show Pony.

#### **Mountain & Moorland (excluding Welsh Breeds and Shetlands)**

This section has been moved to Sunday 17 May for 2020.

For 2020 all horse exhibitors will enter the showground off the A483 Llandrindod Wells road onto Horse Hill and park on Level F. A specific area on Level F will be allocated to those vehicles used for accommodation and caravans as they require the appropriate legal spacing. Tents will be placed on the grassed area adjacent to Level K, as they have to be kept separate to vehicles by law. Please adhere to all the allocated areas.

### RULES & REGULATIONS

#### **EQUINE INFLUENZA**

Following advice from animal health professionals and the prevalence of the Equine Flu in the summer of 2019, the Society Officials have made the decision to allow only horses vaccinated against Equine Flu to attend the 2020 Smallholding and Countryside Festival.

The Society expects all equine entries to have an up-to-date equine influenza vaccination record. They must have received two primary vaccinations which are given not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart.

If sufficient time has elapsed the equine entry must also have received a booster vaccination which is given not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the second component of the primary vaccination, and further booster vaccinations at intervals of not more than a year apart. None of the vaccinations must have been given on the day of entry to the showground or on any of the six days before entry to the showground.

**Note: Minimum requirements are the two primary vaccinations, plus seven days before entry to the showground. Foals six months of age or older must meet the minimum equine influenza vaccination requirement.**

#### **POLITE REMINDER**

For the safety of all concerned, horse exhibitors are kindly asked not to ride around the actual Festival site, before, during or after the event other than on approved practise areas and routes to enter their competitions.

#### **DUPLICATE ROSETTE**

Exhibitors will have the opportunity to purchase a duplicate rosette at a cost of £10. The request will have to be put in writing with the total cost attached. The rosettes will be sent to you after the Festival.

## DON'T FORGET.....

- ❑ Please check that on-line entry forms have been completed correctly and ensure that payment has gone through.
- ❑ Please ensure that the account details required for prize money BACS payment is completed.
- ❑ If the exhibitor is under 18 years of age then the official entry form has to be completed by a parent/guardian/agent who is over 18 years of age. Please note that whoever completes the form takes full responsibility for complying with all rules and regulations.
- ❑ If you intend to use your vehicle for accommodation then you **MUST** indicate this on your entry form in order to receive the relevant pass.
