NODIADAU CYFFREDINOL • CYMHWYSTER GENERAL NOTES • ELIGIBILITY

1. The staging of this section is dependent upon the regulations in force at the time relating to animal diseases.
2. Pig exhibits **must** be BPA registered or where applicable, with relevant Breed Societies. Pig classes are held under BPA Conditions.
3. No children under the age of 11 should enter the pig ring while judging is in progress, other than during the Junior Pig Handling classes. No children under the age of 16 should enter the pig ring whilst judging of boar pigs is in progress.
4. No directly imported pigs allowed. Pigs should be bred in Great Britain or have been in the UK for at least 3 weeks. Checks of pig identification marks/tags/tattoos could be carried out at any time during the Festival.
5. The highest placed pig of **each breed shown** will qualify for entry in the Interbreed Classes.
6. Exhibitors are reminded that heavily pregnant Sows should not be entered in the Show and exhibited.
7. Pig Washing facilities are located at the back of the Pig Pavilion for use by exhibitors. Washing of pigs in the pig lines is strictly forbidden on the ground of contamination and health & safety issues.
8. **In all sections classes may be amalgamated if less than three entries are received. The Chief Steward reserves the right to split large classes in the event of Health & Safety issues.**
9. Please note special regulations relating to Pigs at the back of the Schedule.
10. **It is important that exhibitors of female pigs (all breeds) born before 1st January 2019 shall be eligible to compete only if in the six calendar months prior to the Show they have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age, a birth notified litter of pigs. Female pigs born on or after 1st January and before 1st July in the year before the show must within 18 months of their date of birth have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age a birth notified litter of pigs.**
11. Exhibitors should inform the office or Chief Steward AT ANY STAGE PRIOR to the event if they are unable to attend or bring all of their entries

Conditions of Entry:

1. Qualifying rounds will be arranged at Agricultural Shows, leading to a Final. A condition of entering the competition is that prize winners at preliminary rounds must intend to exhibit at the Final.
2. The award is open to all breeds of pedigree pigs entered in the Festival. The object is to determine the best modern and traditional breed pigs as an example of their respective breeds.
3. All animals entered in this competition must be the property of a member of the British Pig Association or the British Lop Society and must be registered in a herd book of The British Pig Association or the British Lop Pig Society.
4. Judges must be chosen from the BPA "All Breeds" Judges List. They may only act for one qualifying round. The judge of the Final will not have acted for a qualifying round.
5. Classes from which pigs are chosen, and therefore eligible for qualifying rounds, must be judged by a BPA approved judge.
6. To be eligible for a qualifying round, a pig (male or female) must be born on or after 1 July of the year previous to the Festival (see 8 below). A pig judged Best Male (Modern or Traditional) or Best Female (Modern or Traditional) in a qualifying round cannot compete in any subsequent round. If a pig having qualified at an earlier show again qualifies at a later show, the judge for that breed shall select an alternative pig of the same breed and sex from any class covering the required age group.
7. Where a single breed has more than one class covering the required age group for either sex, so permitting more than one 1st prize animal, the judge must nominate one of these for the qualifying round.
8. Where there are multi-breed classes, i.e. any other modern/any other traditional breed or a similar classification, the judge must nominate the best male and best female of the qualifying age of each breed represented (regardless of class prizes). These pigs will compete in the qualifying round with eligible entries from individual breed classes.
9. At each qualifying round, the judge will select the Best Male from a Modern Breed, Best Male from a Traditional Breed, Best Female from a Modern Breed, Best Female from a Traditional Breed and Best Pig.
10. Prize money for preliminary rounds will be £10 for the best Modern Breed pig of each sex and £10 for the best Traditional Breed pig of each sex, with £10 and a glass trophy for the overall winner.

Note: Rosettes only will be presented at each preliminary round. Prize monies and glass trophies for preliminary rounds will be presented at the Final.

11. The Best Males Modern and Traditional and Best Females Modern and Traditional from each of the qualifying rounds will qualify for the Final to be held at the Great Yorkshire Show.
12. The Final will be to judge the Best Modern Male and Female with Reserves and the Best Traditional Male and Female with Reserves; the Best Pig (i.e. Pig of the Year) and Reserve.
13. In the Final at Great Yorkshire Show the Modern and Traditional Male and Female Champions will each receive £60, Reserve Champions £30, Overall Champion £200 and The Geoffrey Cloke Memorial Salver, and Reserve £150.
14. A travel allowance of 10p per mile will be paid by the Great Yorkshire Show to exhibitors attending the Final.

2. The award is open to all breeds of pedigree pigs entered in the Festival. The object is to determine the best young pig born in the year of the show as an example of their respective breeds.
3. All animals entered in this competition must be the property of a member of the British Pig Association and must be litter notified and registered in BPA's herd books or the herdbook of the British Lop Society.
4. Judges must be chosen from the BPA "All Breeds" Judges List. They may only act for one qualifying round. The judge of the Final will not have acted for a qualifying round.
5. Classes from which pigs are chosen, and therefore eligible for qualifying rounds, must be judged by a BPA approved judge.
6. To be eligible for a qualifying round, a pig (male or female) must be born on or after 1st January of the year of the Festival (see 8 below). A pig judged Best Young Male or Best Young Female in a qualifying round cannot compete in any subsequent round. If a pig having qualified at an earlier show again qualifies at a later show the judge for that breed shall select an alternative pig of the same breed and sex from any class covering the required age group.
7. Where a single breed has more than one class covering the required age group for either sex, so permitting more than one 1st prize animal, the judge must nominate one of these for the qualifying round.
8. Where there are multi-breed classes, i.e. any other modern/any other traditional breed or a similar classification, the judge must nominate the best male and best female of the qualifying age of each breed represented (regardless of class prizes). These pigs will compete in the qualifying round with eligible entries from individual breed classes.
9. At each qualifying round the judge will select the Best Young Male and Best Young Female.
10. The Best Young Male and Best Young Female from each of the qualifying rounds will enter the Final. Prizes for preliminary rounds will be a glass trophy for the best young pig of each sex.

Note: Rosettes only will be presented at each preliminary round. Glass trophies for preliminary rounds will be presented at the Final.

11. The final will be to Judge the Best Modern Male and Female with Reserves and the Best Traditional Male and Female with Reserves; the Best Pig (i.e Young Pig of the Year) and Reserve.
12. In the Final at The Malvern Autumn Show, the Modern and Traditional Male and Female Champions will each receive £60, Reserve Champions £30, Overall Champion £200 and The Jack Howlett Memorial Trophy and Reserve £150.
