Frequently Asked Questions

- **How can I enter my horse?**

You will be able to enter your horse via our online entry forms. Details of how to enter will be available via a link on our website opening from **Wednesday 1st March 2023 at 10.00am**.

- **When do entries open and close?**

Entries open on Wednesday 1st March 2023 at 10.00am and close on Monday 3rd April 2023 at 11.59pm.

- **How many tickets do I get if I enter?**

Exhibitors will be issued with TWO admission tickets for each day he/she will be exhibiting - **2 Adults OR 1 Adult/1 Child for all children's classes** (16 years and under), along with ONE vehicle pass. Additional exhibitor tickets will be available for purchase.

- **Does my horse need to be vaccinated to be able to attend?**

Guidance on Equine Influenza Vaccination:

The Society expects all equine entries to have an up-to-date equine influenza vaccination record. They must have received two primary vaccinations which are given not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart.

If sufficient time has elapsed the equine entry must also have received a booster vaccination which is given not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the second component of the primary vaccination, and further booster vaccinations at intervals of not more than a year apart.

None of the vaccinations must have been given on the day of entry to the showground or on any of the six days before entry to the showground.

Note: Minimum requirements are the two primary vaccinations, plus seven days before entry to the showground. Foals six months of age or older must meet the minimum equine influenza vaccination requirement.



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- **Will stables be available to use on the showground?**

Stables will be available to use during the event from Friday to Sunday. Access will be granted to exhibitors on Friday 19th May 2023 from 4.00pm – 8.00pm and from 6.30am on Saturday 20th May and Sunday 21st May. Stables are charged at £45 for 1 night or £50 for 2 nights.

- **I am an exhibitor when will I be able to access the showground?**

All Horseboxes to arrive through Horse Hill Gate (off the A483). Access will be granted to the showground on Friday 19th May 2023 between 4.00 – 8.00 pm ONLY; access on Saturday 20th May and Sunday 21st May is from 6.30am.

- **Do I need to bring my own Straw?**

Initial supply of one small straw bale (per stable booked) will be provided. Exhibitors will be issued with one ticket per stable booked, which can be exchanged for one small straw bale with the Stable Manager.

Extra straw will be made available at a cost of £5 per small bale.

- **I am an exhibitor, can I stay on the showground during the event?**

Yes. You are able to stay on the showground Friday and Saturday night. Exhibitors may purchase a tent pass at £20.00 or a caravan pass at £30.00 as accommodation. There is no electric hook-up available.

OTHER VEHICLES USED FOR ACCOMMODATION:

With Health and Safety/Fire Regulations having to be rigorously administered, exhibitors MUST state on their remittance form if their vehicle will be used for accommodation during the event. There will not be a fee for exhibitors using their vehicles for accommodation. To ensure compliance with Fire Safety Regulations, all vehicles used for accommodation MUST carry a suitable fire extinguisher (5-kilo dry powder type).

- **Photography**

EquinePix Photography will be in attendance on both days of the event for you to order photographs.

- **Vets & Duty Farrier**

Vets are on standby at the event and can be contacted via the Society Stewards. There will be two duty farriers at the event – contact details included in the schedule.
