#### Frequently Asked Questions

- **How can I enter my animals?**

You will be able to enter via our online entry System. Details of how to enter will be available via a link on our website [www.rwas.wales](http://www.rwas.wales) opening from **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2023 at 10.00am**. You will need to create an RWAS Account prior to submitting your entries online. If you cannot access the online system entry forms will be available from the main office on the 1<sup>st</sup> March.

- **When do entries open and close?**

Entries open on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2023 at 10.00am and close on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2023 at 11.59pm.

- **How many tickets do I get if I enter?**

- **What paperwork do I need to be able to attend?**

~ Cattle are required to submit proof of a valid TB test, and a negative antigen BVD Test for all individual animals entered. You must bring the corresponding passport for the animals with you.

~ All movement licences will need to be completed upon arrival (please fill out as much as you can prior to arrival).

~ CAE - A copy of your valid certificate will need to be brought with you.

- **I am an exhibitor when will I be able to access the showground?**



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All livestock must enter via the Livestock entrance within the allocated times.

- **Do I need to bring my own Straw?**

An Initial supply of straw will be provided. Exhibitors are required to provide their own feed, including green fodder.

- **I am an exhibitor, can I stay on the showground during the event?**

Yes. You are able to stay on the showground Friday and Saturday night. Exhibitors may purchase a tent pass at £20.00 or a caravan pass at £45.00 as accommodation. We also have a limited number of spaces in the onsite accommodation Neuadd Henllan @ £150.00 per person for the duration of the event (this is allocated on a first come basis).

**OTHER VEHICLES USED FOR ACCOMMODATION:**

With Health and Safety/Fire Regulations having to be rigorously administered, exhibitors MUST state on their remittance form if their vehicle will be used for accommodation during the event. There will not be a fee for exhibitors using their vehicles for accommodation. To ensure compliance with Fire Safety Regulations, all vehicles used for accommodation MUST carry a suitable fire extinguisher (5-kilo dry powder type). This must be selected under the accommodation heading online when submitting your entries.

- **Photography**

Photographers will be in attendance on both days of the event for you to order photographs.

- **Vets**

Vets are on standby at the event and can be contacted via the Society Stewards.
