# RHEOLAU I'R YMGEISWYR

## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR COMPETITORS

### **Before leaving home:**

- Check the Pigeons and make sure they are fit and healthy and cages are clean
- Follow the procedure for enhanced biosecurity. Declaration form to be completed and collected by the stewards on arrival. Further details and declaration form to follow
- Pigeons will be checked by an expert before entering the Fur and Feather Pavilion.

1. All entries to be submitted via the online portal via the link by:  
**Tuesday 28 October 2025.**  
**WE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING ANY LATE ENTRIES AFTER THIS DATE.**
2. An exhibitor entering £16.00 or more, will be allowed one free admission ticket to the Fair. Juveniles who enter £6 or more will be allowed one free child admission ticket to the Fair. Empty pens will be monitored.
3. **NO BIRDS CAN BE ENTERED ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW**
4. Birds will not be fed or watered. Exhibitors to provide own drinkers. Water and watering cans will be available in the Pavilion.
5. All birds / eggs to be penned / staged between 7.30am - 9.00am on Monday.
6. Judging will commence at 9.30am prompt.
7. The section will be open to the public during judging.
8. Security tags will be available for use upon request on completion of judging.
9. Presentation of prizes to take place at 4.00pm.
10. **Unpenning 4.00pm**, all exhibits must remain in their cages until this time. **No birds to be left in the building after 4.30pm.** No person may handle, pen or repack any exhibit without the permission of the stewards in charge.
11. Please note that the staging of the Pigeon Section is dependent upon the regulations in force at the time of the Show relating to Avian Influenza (Bird Flu) or any other notifiable disease. The Royal Welsh Agricultural Society Ltd. are continually working with Welsh Government & APHA to ensure that all rules and regulations are implemented for the event. We will inform you of the biosecurity requirements that are in place prior to the event, as matters stand within the licence terms, we will implement the enhanced biosecurity procedure.
12. The Royal Welsh Agricultural Society is committed to protecting your personal data and processing it only in accordance with legal requirements. For more details you should request a copy of our GDPR policy. We process your personal data as it is necessary for the performance of our contract with you to facilitate your entry to the Show. We will not transfer your data outside of the UK and EEA (European Economic

Area) and will not share your data with third parties. Results will also be circulated with members of the Press and published on our website. We retain your data in accordance with our retention schedule to simplify future applications. You have various rights in the data we hold including rectification and objecting to processing.

13. The Society and stewards will take reasonable care for the safety of exhibits only, but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and all other persons, that the Society will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any exhibit during transit or at the Fair, whether arising from an accident or any other cause whatsoever, nor for any act of omission of themselves their officers, agents, servants, or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received, and exhibitors will be required to hold the Society blameless in the event of any loss.

### 13. **PARKING**

On completion of unloading Egg & Pigeon exhibitors are asked to remove their vehicles and park in the designated parking area in the Forestry section entry via the FORESTRY GATE. Only exhibitors with the official 'Poultry Exhibitors Car Pass' will be able to gain entry into this area. This gate will be locked at 9.30am and reopened and manned between 3.30pm and 4.30pm. After this time exhibitors would have to park on the Lower Showground after delivering their exhibits. Parking will be co-ordinated by the security company; your co-operation would be very much appreciated.

14. The Society will comply with Welsh Government on the movement of birds. The Society reserves the right to cancel the section or introduce advance biosecurity procedures. In the event of this being necessary, the full co-operation of the exhibitors would be much appreciated.
15. No entry fees will be reimbursed if the competition is staged with permission from the Chief Veterinary Officer for Wales and the contingency planned implemented in the event of an outbreak of a notifiable disease within the UK.

### **RHEOLAU PARTHED PROTESTIADAU - REGULATIONS TO PROTESTS**

16. Any exhibitor or member wishing to lodge a protest, having reference to a prize awarded to any exhibit at the Show, must deposit with the Chief Sectional Steward the sum of £25.00. If on investigation the protest is not sustained to the satisfaction of the Board of Directors the sum thus deposited may be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All protests must be delivered to the Chief Steward **before 3.30pm on the day on which the award in dispute may have been made**, no protest will be subsequently received unless a satisfactory reason be assigned for the delay.
17. Parties interested in objections may be asked to attend a meeting at the Head of Administration's Office on the Showground at 4.00pm on the day in which the objection is laid. Prizes not objected to will be paid to the respective winners when duly qualified to receive them.
