#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Monitoring of pens relating to stock not forward will take place during the Show and prior to exhibitors collecting admission tickets.

MONDAY - One admission ticket will be handed to exhibitors on arrival at the declaration point. If the exhibitor qualifies for a second ticket, this can be collected from the Chief Steward after he has confirmed that the exhibitor concerned has brought the correct number of entries required. Please note all entry fees are inclusive of VAT.

### 5. **JUDGING)**

Judging will commence at 9.30am on both days

No person or persons will be allowed in the Fur and Feather Pavilion while judging is in progress. The Pavilion will open to the public at 12.30pm or on completion of judging.

### 6. **JUDGES AWARD AT THEIR OWN DISCRETION AND THE JUDGES DISCISION IS FINAL. Judges have been asked to report back to the section at 2.00pm on the judging day to discuss the adjudication with exhibitors.**

7. Exhibitors acting as Judges' Stewards at the Show may not assist with any classes in which they have entries.

8. The Society will take reasonable care for the safety of exhibits, and for any other property entrusted to it, but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors, and all other persons, that the Society will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any exhibit, boxes, hampers or other property during transit or at the Show, whether arising from an accident or any other cause whatever, nor for any act of omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants, or others; and it is on this understanding only that entries and claims are received, and exhibitors will be required to hold the Society blameless in the event of any loss.

9. The Society will appoint suitable persons to attend to the exhibits free of charge, and no person may handle, pen or repack any exhibits without the permission of the Stewards in charge.

15. Any exhibitor or member wishing to lodge a protest, having reference to a prize awarded to any exhibit at the Show, must deposit with the Chief Steward the sum of £25.00. If on investigation the protest is not sustained to the satisfaction of the Board of Directors the sum thus deposited may be forfeited to the funds of the Society. All protests must be delivered to the Chief Steward **before 4.00pm on the day on which the award in dispute may have been made**, no protest will be subsequently received unless a satisfactory reason be assigned for the delay.
16. Parties interested in objections may be asked to attend a meeting at the Head of Administration's Office on the Showground at 5.00pm on the day in which the objection is laid. Prizes not objected to will be paid to the respective winners when duly qualified to receive them.

- 2 If the exhibitor is under 18 years of age then the entry online has to be completed by a parent/guardian who is over 18 years of age. Please note that whoever completes the entry form takes full responsibility for complying with all rules and regulations.
- 3 **Challenge Cups and Trophies – PLEASE NOTE:-** The Challenge Cups and Trophies are permanently housed in a purpose made Trophy Room situated in the Clwyd Glamorgan Hall. The winner of each Challenge Cup and Trophy will be awarded an Official RWAS Memento as a keepsake, their name will also be engraved on the Challenge Cups and Trophies. ### **We would like to highlight the following from the license:**

- Flocks of Poultry & Pigeons should be registered. The CPH number is essential.
- The health of birds should be checked before leaving home.
- The premises of origin for any birds attending a gathering must be registered with the Animal and Plant Health Agency on the GB Pigeons Register and that the keeper of any birds attending the gathering will need to provide evidence of registration before being granted entry;
- Ensure that no birds are allowed to enter a gathering unless the participant declares that they do not originate from premises or areas which are under restrictions related to suspicion or confirmation of a notifiable avian disease, including from any temporary disease control zone imposed by Ministers or that the premises is in an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone and can provide a valid CPH number to verify this.
- Your declaration form, vehicle along with cages/boxes will be checked by the biosecurity assistant before you are allowed entry onto the Showground.
- The above form will be sent to you with your ticket and admission packs.
- Your vehicle, cages and boxes must be clean.
- You will be allowed entry one exhibitor at a time, stock brought forward by exhibitors must not be mixed before the vet has checked them.
- You should also check that birds have not got or been in contact with or have any signs of the following:

Swollen head, blue discoloration of neck, throat and comb, loss of appetite, respiratory distress such as gaping beak, coughing, sneezing, gurgling, rattling, diarrhea, fewer eggs laid or general dullness.
